Dressage

Ali and Rose have spent a lot of time bringing our entries system fully up to date and from now on entries need to be done using the online platform Equo Events. Please register yourself with Equo to enable your WRC Actual Dressage entries to be processed from now on. (Does NOT apply to Virtual Dressage entries) There is a small booking fee applied and with this in consideration the club has aimed to keep entry costs at a minimum but having to increase the entry price it has gone up slightly to £14 per class.

We are very much looking forward to welcoming you to our first competition of 2023 on 26th March. If you need any help with entries or support to come to our dressage – or even just to know there will be a welcoming friendly face which you will have at the event for sure, please do ask. We just ask for small donations for a caller and for the refreshments on offer too. Please come and see what they are all about on foot and support the riders. Help is always required so if you would like to add up or help others get into the arena or even make a cup of tea for the judge and scribe! Ali would love to hear from you.

Meanwhile the Virtual Dressage runs throughout the year with entries £8 a go by the 20th each month directly to Ali as before. Here you need a horse to ride and a 20x 40 arena (grass area is fine if messaged and markers set out that are clearly visible) - next find a lovely, patient, steady handed friend to help- they stand at the letter C and film your test for that month which you then submit for judging. You then get your scoresheet back from the judge that month, a rosette if you place and a chance for points for the WRC annual virtual league. You can dressage away when convenient for you with no need to dress up yourself or plait your pony. Please again let us know if you need to know more about any of it.

Area 17 Events

Sam works hard for us all as our club representative for area competitions - our club falls within British Riding Club Area 17 and so we are eligible to enter these area qualifier events. This year these are:

This is the first ever area competition organised by WRC and the subcommittee have already secured the venue, which will be at Woodington. Judges and a photographer will also be organised but there will be numerous jobs prior to the competition and on the day. We really hope that everyone who wishes to be part of this whether riding or as part of the planning team or help on the day gets involved to make it a success, so please again let us know if you are happy to offer your services.

For competing, please email Sam if you have any interest in riding for WRC in any of these events either as an individual or if we have enough interest as part of our team. Winners qualify for the subsequent British Riding Club National competitions further afield. WRC is very generous contributing some costs towards entries for all area events so please enter if you're able to - you will have the support of the club.

Pleasure Riding Scheme

Emma remains your contact for PRS membership, and we say another huge welcome to all renewing members and all new members to the scheme for 2023.

Anybody wishing to join can still do so for £12 lasting until 31st December this year so although ideally join in January for the best value it is never too late! Rosettes are awarded for riding hours such as hacking or schooling on any horse but excluding hours ridden in lessons or competitions. You keep your own log and upon achieving 50 hrs you notify Emma and receive your first rosette. There is no limit to the number of rosettes you achieve whilst a member and they go up in increments of 50 hrs to 300 then in 100's to 2000 hours with a Bronze, silver and gold super rosette when you get there!

There is also an opt in or out exclusive to members What's app group where we share rides and our lovely steeds wearing their ribbons.

So do join the PRS or message Emma with any questions if you would like to and of course wishing you all happy riding onto your next rosettes!

 Event
- As of the 1st of January, riding hats with the following standard are <u>no longer allowed PAS 015 1998, SNELL 2001</u>. Any Aqua hat tags are no longer accepted.
